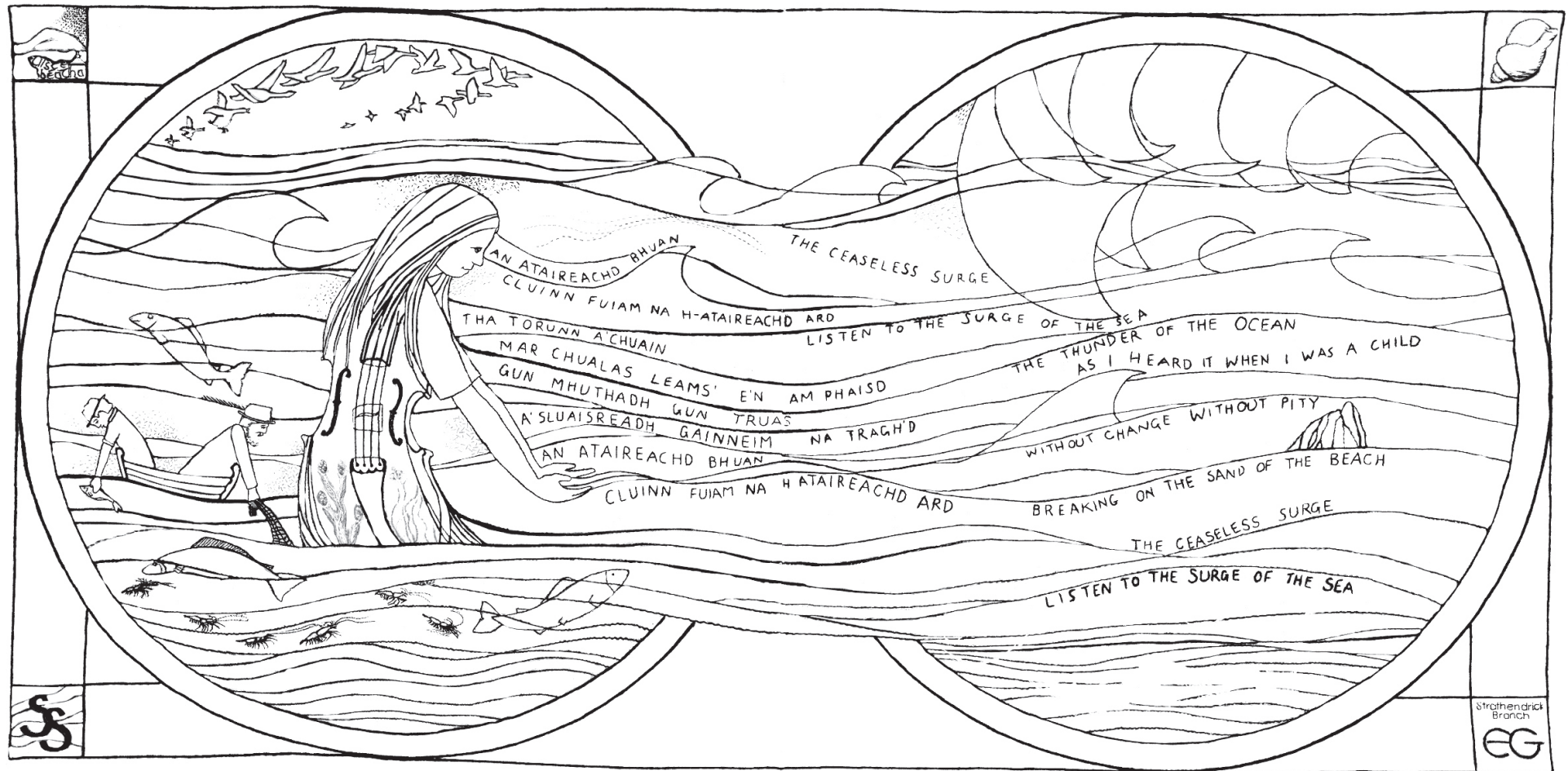


COLOUR-IN *panel* #159
