

Camp Information

- Registration/start time Morning - 8:30am-9:00am
- Camp Morning Start – 9:00am
- Lunch Time Bolt on 12:30-1:30pm
- Camp Finish/Pick up Morning – 12:30pm
- Camp Start Afternoon- 1:30pm
- Camp Finish/Pickup Afternoon- 5pm
- All day Camp- Drop off from 8:30am pick up by 5pm.

Registration for the morning session will start from 8:30am, please report to the main reception. A team member will guide you to the registration area. All children must be signed in and out of the holiday camp.

Registration for the afternoon session will start from 1:30pm, please report to the main reception. A team member will guide you to the registration area. All children must be signed in and out of the holiday camp.

Morning Camp finishes at 12:30pm. Please be available to pick your child up by this time.

Afternoon Camp finishes at 5pm. Please be available to pick up your child by this time.

There is a Lunch option in which your child can stay over lunch between 12:30pm-1:30pm. This is available for both morning and afternoon sessions.

The lunch option is already included in the all day camp.

Cancellations

Holiday camps are non-refundable or transferable. If you must cancel, we will try accommodating a different date for you if possible.

Live Borders reserves the right to cancel Camp B sessions due unavoidable/ unforeseen circumstances.

In the case of Live Borders cancelling Camp B, we will provide 5 days' notice and provide full refunds.

Food and water

We kindly ask that all children attending bring a filled water bottle and a snack to have during the session.

If your child is staying all day or attending the lunch option, we ask you send them with a packed lunch as lunch will not be provided.

Please avoid including any common allergy related foods in packed lunches. Items such as nuts, nut-based spreads, and products containing sesame as we may have some kids at the camps with allergies related to foods in packed lunches.

Kids to coach ratio

Camp B aims to be inclusive and welcoming to all children. Children who require 1-to-1 support or additional care are very welcome to attend.

However, please note that our coaches work to a set coach-to-child ratio and are unable to provide dedicated 1-to-1 supervision. Parents or carers will therefore need to provide an appropriate support person to attend alongside their child for the duration of the camp.

First Aid

First aiders will always be on site during the camps and provided basic first aid should this be required. If your child is injured or upset during the camp, we will contact you immediately.

Photographic images- Consent

On the day of the camp the coaches will ask you if you're happy for your child's photo to be taken. If you do consent to your child's photo being taken, we will ask you to complete a form on the morning of the camp.
